How to Create a UCLA Logon ID

You will need a UCLA Logon ID to access CTSI application systems. You do not need to be a UCLA affiliate to get a UCLA Logon ID.

Step 1: Create a UCLA Logon ID. Copy and Paste or Type this link in the web browser and then, press the Enter key: https://accounts.iam.ucla.edu/register

Step 2: You will be brought to this page. Click on the box to indicate agreement and then, click the I AGREE TO THE TERMS OF SERVICE.
